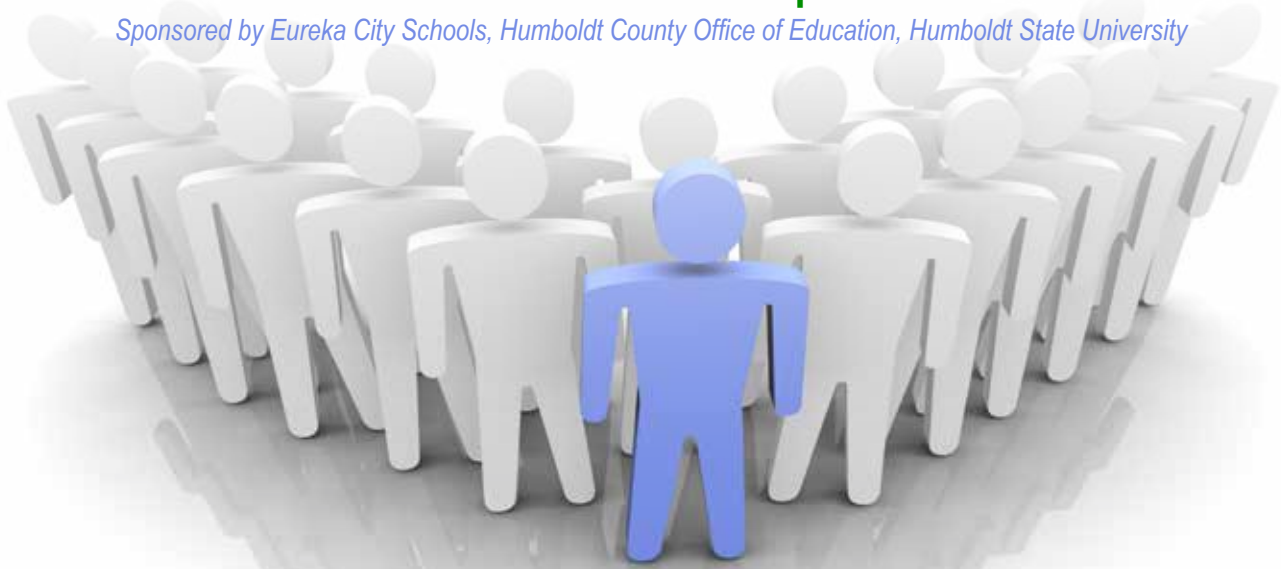


LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Each session will begin with a group discussion of one chapter of a book on leadership, *Monday Morning Leadership*. Guest speakers will follow with a brief overview of key elements related to their field of expertise. At the close of the evening, the group will discuss insights prompted by information from the speakers.

The Leadership Academy will provide participants with an overview of school administration. It may be of interest to those aspiring to enter a credential program, or those wondering if administration might match their goals, as well as those who may not see this as a career path but are simply interested in gaining a greater understanding of the responsibilities involved in leading a school community.
